

Biometric student registration kits delivered to CHS

Prof. Kiama who is the chair of the University of Nairobi biometric student registration and information system said biometric registration will help the university to capture student information and ease retrieval of student data. The key components of the kit include; laptop, fingerprints scanner, digital camera signature pad, documents scanner USB herb photography equipment, lamps and UPS.
